

## Report from your County Councillor, Cllr Steffan Aquarone



### **Campaigning to protect health and care services**

Rural services are in dire decline, and I'm deeply worried about the lack of dentists, doctors' appointments, and mental health services in North Norfolk.

This is one of my central concerns and I've been campaigning on some of the most acute threats to our rural health and care services:

- Proposed closure of Blakeney GP surgery. Surgeries can't just open and close as they wish - they're contracted as part of an overall plan, managed by Norfolk and Waveney Integrated Care Board (ICB), for meeting the health needs of the people in our area.

The initial request for closure put forward by Holt Medical Practice is, however, a worrying thing for our area as it could mean losing vital local surgery provision. I have corresponded with both Holt Medical Practice and Dame Patricia Hewitt, and believe it's vitally important that individuals make submissions directly to the consultation. I would hate to lose out to procedure, which is why I want strongly to encourage all parties to make their submission via the consultation when it opens, as indicated to me by the ICB, between the 17th July and 30th September. Even and especially if they've completed one of the two existing surveys already. I will write to households and make this point.

In addition, the more circumstantial the account given, the better: this is who I am and the circumstances I am in (or will be in, in the future), this is what the impact of the closure will be on me and my family. Transport alone is not enough - the finer details of what people will have to do if the surgery closes need to be spelled out.

- Proposed closure of Benjamin Court in Cromer. This is one of only a small number of units where patients can be discharged from hospital to recover. The proposal to replace it with home-based care will lead to untold misery and suffering by those people whose homes are totally unsuitable for recovery.

### **The ongoing call for Bank Hubs**

The closure of Lloyds branches in Cromer and North Walsham is yet another blow to our rural communities and leaves us with just one remaining bank in the towns.

I have already submitted a community request to Link (better known as the cash machine people) for one of their Bank Hubs for Holt, following the last branch (Barclays)
